



Hiring Dance Instructors

Dance Instructors should be qualified to teach beginning through advanced levels of Ballet, Jazz, Modern, Contemporary, Tap, Musical Theatre and/or Hip Hop. This Way To Broadway Performing Arts Instructors are professionally trained dancers invested in sharing their passion for the art with young dancers. Instructors should lead by example in areas such as punctuality, responsibility, motivation, and professionalism.

Responsibilities Include:

- Effectively design and plan curriculums for all levels and populations according to the This Way To Broadway Performing Arts Syllabus.
- Prepare progressive lesson plans which will enhance the experience of program participants.
- Record and maintain attendance records.
- Set up dance space and return space to neat state upon completion of class.
- Accurately complete all administrative duties relating to dance classes (i.e. timesheets, recital forms, etc.)
- Choreograph one dance per class for end of year recitals.
- Attend staff meetings.
- Report injuries and complete required forms.
- Immediately notify a supervisor of any broken equipment or unsafe aspects of studio space.
- Perform other duties as assigned by dance directors.

Qualifications:

- Degree in Dance, Certified in R.A.D, B.A.T.D, C.D.T.A, A.D.A.P.T, or Professional Dance experience
- Displays exceptional interpersonal skills and a high level of customer service
- Displays excellent problem solving skills and initiative
